Location: Provided safe access is available, we will arrange for the activity to be undertaken within walking distance of your school— *Down at Your Local Creek*.

Duration: 2 hrs

Topics: Students will receive an introduction to the topics of catchments and ecological monitoring. A range of field tests and data will be collected that will enable students to gain an understanding of the creeks health and issues impacting upon it. These include waterbug dip netting, surveying weeds and native vegetation and water pH, turbidity and salinity.
