Curriculum and Activities

The learning program involves two sessions: the first explores the concepts of urban catchment health and care, the second involves a series of practical activities focusing on ecological monitoring and water quality testing. Data collected from a range of field tests is used to evaluate the health of the waterway and to identify issues impacting upon it. The field tests include water invertebrate dip netting, chemical and physical water quality tests, and creek-side vegetation surveys. Students will acquire background knowledge of waterway health and develop the skills, understanding and awareness required to protect Brisbane's waterways
